

PRESIDENT

ELECTION:

Elected by the Chapter membership at the Annual Meeting in uneven years for a three-year term.

MEMBER OF:

Executive Committee, Board of Directors and shall be ex-officio member of all committees, except the Nominating and Chapter Ethics Committees.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- A. Attend and preside at membership, Executive Committee and BOD meetings.
- B. Call meetings of the BOD in accordance with TPTA bylaws. At least two meetings per year are required.
- C. Call special meetings of the Chapter as determined by the Executive Committee.
- D. Call all regular business meetings, a minimum of one annually.
- E. Submit report for each BOD meeting and make an annual report to the Chapter.
- F. Prepare annual budget. The following activities may be included as finances permit:
 - 1. BOD Retreat.

- 2. Attendance at House of Delegates as well as Council on Chapter President's pre- and post-House.
- 3. Attendance at Council on Chapter Presidents at Combined Section Meeting.
- 4. Attendance by Parliamentarian at Chapter meetings.
- 5. Chapter officer training.
- 6. Contribution to Foundation for Physical Therapy.
- G Assist in Strategic Planning process and update assigned tasks through the year.
- H. Confer with successor regarding outline of routine duties and transfer files.
- I. Assume leadership of Chapter activities and attempt to develop the Chapter in accordance with the APTA policies, membership needs and interests.
- J. Turn over pertinent correspondence and communications to the Executive Director for filing.
- K. Serve as the official spokesman for the Chapter to all groups and associations.
- L. Act as immediate supervisor for Chapter's Executive Director.
- M. Notify candidates of election results after elections.
- N. Be named on the Annual Corporate Charter renewal forms as the Chapter's legal agent.
- O. Present contractual arrangements made by the Chapter over \$500 to the TPTA Executive Committee for approval. These contracts should be signed by a member of the TPTA Executive Committee. Exception will be Exhibitor contracts.
- P. In conjunction with Vice-President or Treasurer, authorized to negotiate and/or obligate TPTA to loans or other financial arrangements in accordance with

budget restraints, strategic planning or other BOD actions.
